Darin- We don't need to spend all \$25,000 from the sale of the land in back of the Community Center on the Cemeteries. The Highway garage is in need of some repairs, the roof is leaking in one spot, insulation is falling down and there is rot on the bottom. Supervisor will have Bill make up a list what is needed to repair the Highway Garage.

The door and fascia at the youth Center needs repair too.

Bill wanted to build a small pavillion at the Library and the Library didn't want it. They thought it would be blocking their view of the building. Then Bill suggested building one on Festival Field. Board thought that was a good ideal and will get with Bill in the next couple of weeks and put some stakes in the ground and build something we can use.
